POSSIBLE ASSASSINATION ATTEMPT
 AGAINST SENATOR EDWARD M. KENNEDY

On 11/27/79, Special Clerk (SC) [redacted] was assigned to complaint duty at WFO. At approximately 11:05 a.m., she received a call from a person identifying himself as [redacted] Cal Creek, Oregon 97410. He alluded to an assassination attempt against Senator KENNEDY which was to take place in the Pacific Northwest, but regarding which he would provide no other details.

At 11:23 a.m. on 11/27/79, Special Agent (SA) [redacted] contacted [redacted] at [redacted].

[redacted] stated that he had "intelligence information that something would happen in the Northwest Washington, Oregon, or Northern California area, that would start a war - possibly an assassination attempt on Senator KENNEDY."

[redacted] then said, "Turn your recorder up louder and I'm not going to answer 20 questions. I'm just saying that there could be a possible assassination attempt in the Northwest."

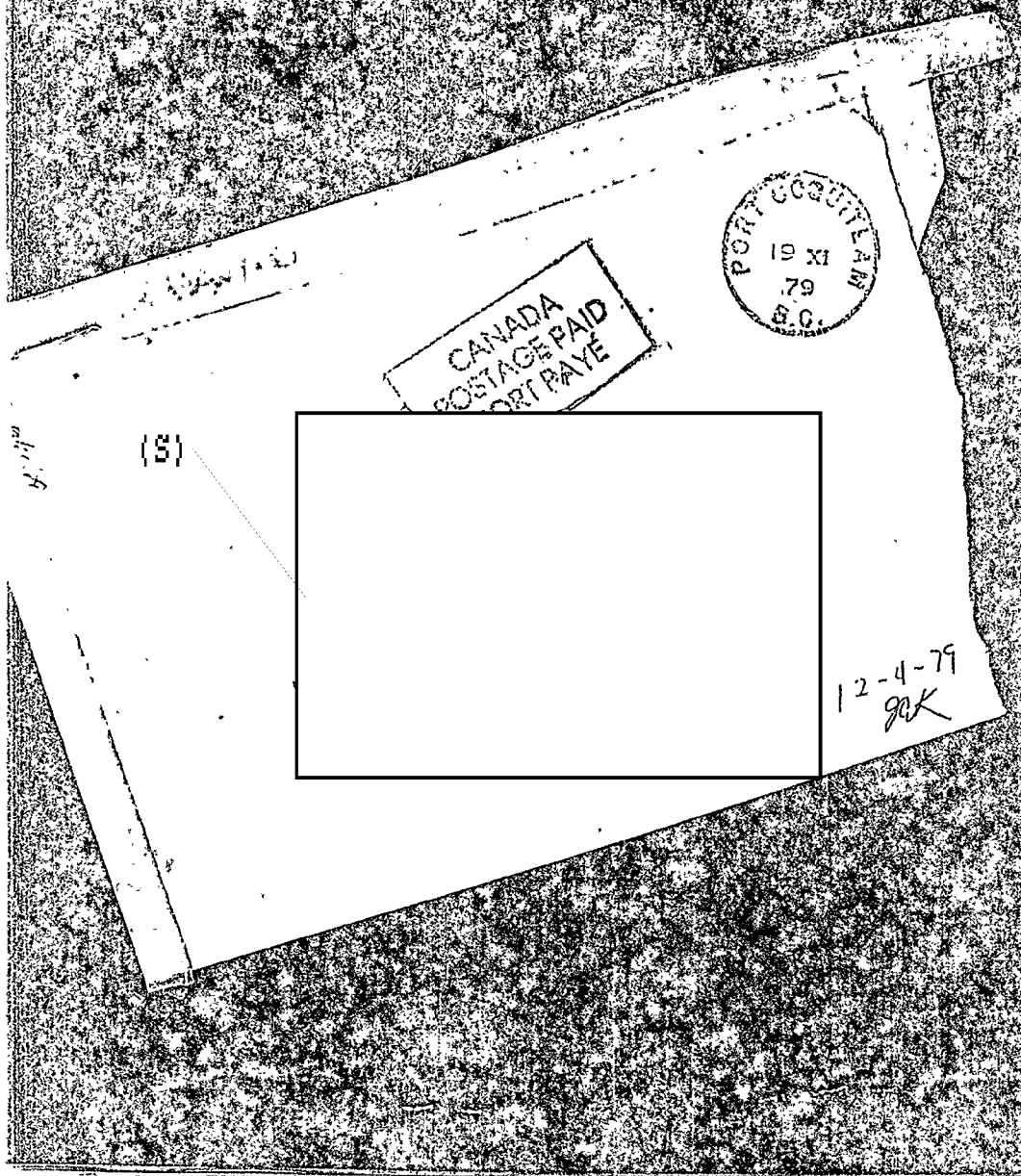

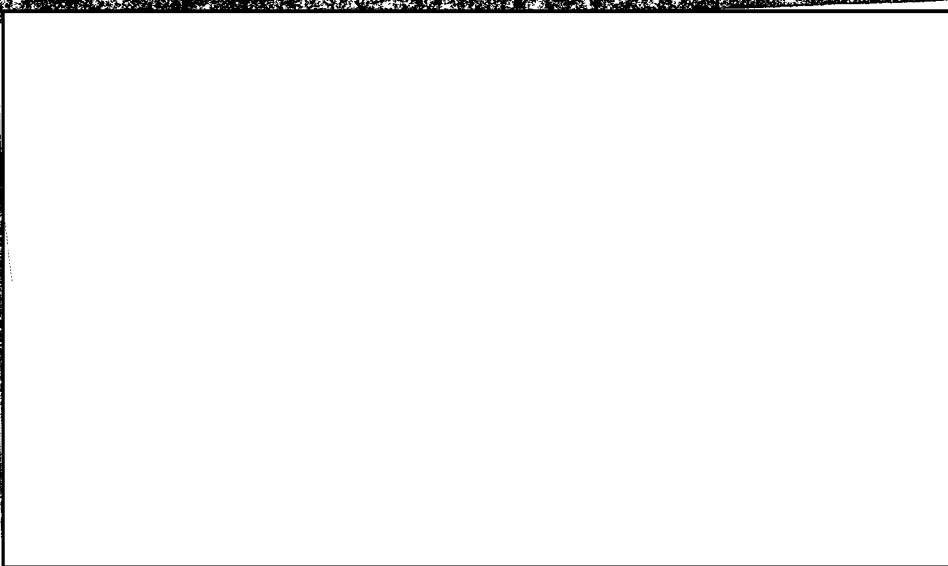

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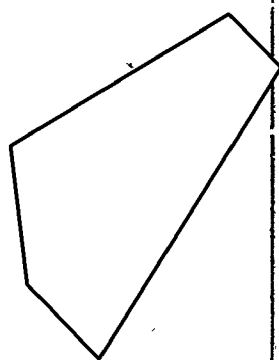

On June 5, 1980, the Phoenix Division of the FBI received a local telephone call from Reverend [redacted] Minister of Church of God of Heaven, who resides at [redacted] Scottsdale, Arizona 85257, telephone number [redacted].

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This call related to a telephone call received by Reverend [redacted] on June 2, 1980, at 7:30 p.m., from an unknown male subject in which he demanded \$1,000 and also stated that his group, who are Communist terrorists, have planned to kill Senator Edward Kennedy on his next trip to Houston or Dallas, Texas. He stated there are two to four men who will get him for sure; for if one misses him, the next man will kill him. This Communist group will operate without trouble if Kennedy is dead because he is a strong leader of the country and is against communism and they do not want him to become President.

Several men in this group have called Reverend [redacted] numerous times demanding money of which he refused to comply with their request.

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This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

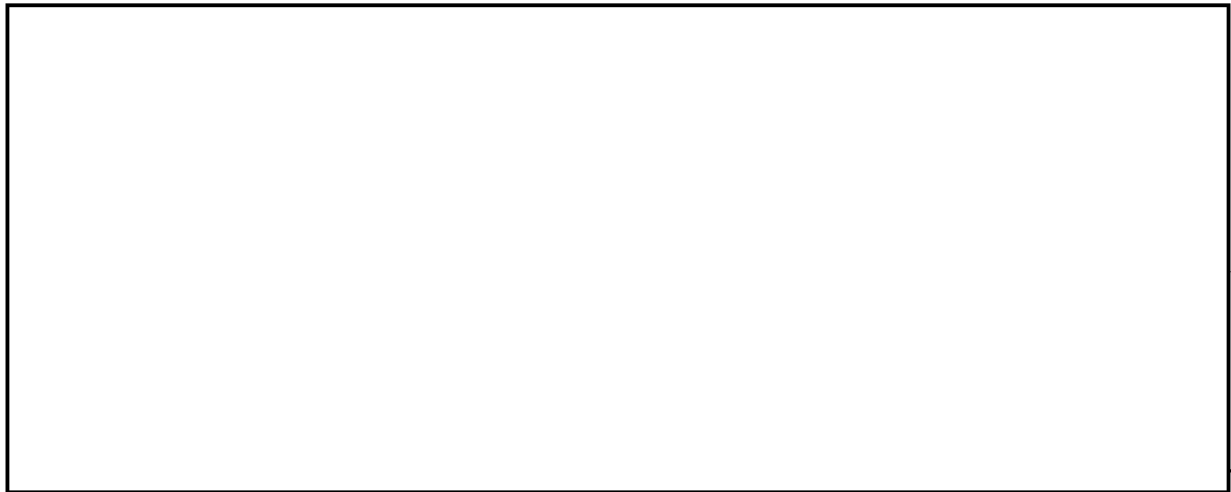

They verified the "pressure & look-alikes to Kennedy" around me but we (the F.B.I.) cannot prove what there were for." I don't think there is any question in anybody's mind but that I have been set-up in a scam to insinuate that Senator Kennedy has been involved.

Your April 28th letter to Special Agent [redacted] enclosing the attached correspondence from Ms. [redacted] has been brought to my attention.

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Ms. [redacted] first contacted the Bureau in 1979 complaining that she was being harassed by men who look like Senator Edward Kennedy although she had originally believed it was actually Senator Kennedy. On another occasion she furnished a list of license plates of individuals looking like Senator Kennedy who she claimed had attempted to run her off the road during a weekend trip.

Based on the information in Ms. [redacted] communication to you and the data she has previously furnished the Bureau, there is no indication of a violation of Federal law falling within our investigative authority. If she has not already done so, she should notify her local law enforcement authorities regarding her fear for her safety and that of her daughters and the United States Postal Service with regard to her statement that someone is tampering with her mail.

I hope this information will assist you in responding to Ms. [redacted]

PURPOSE: To provide to the Criminal Investigative Division (CID) material received by staff members of the House Permanent Select Committee on Intelligence and to recommend appropriate action.

DETAILS: On January 25, 1984, [redacted] staff member, HPSCI, telephonically advised that several staff members of the Committee had received printed material through the U. S. Mail containing derogatory statements about Senator Kennedy and others. She advised that although the material did not seem to contain direct threats against the recipient's, the vituperative nature of the material caused them to be concerned that perhaps it might be an implied threat. Those receiving the material were [redacted]. The recipients had no idea as to why they were selected to receive the material, and speculated that their addresses may have been obtained from the Congressional Staff Directory.

Based on directions from the Congressional Affairs Office (CAO) Ms. [redacted] sent the attached material to the FBI for analysis. She stated that she did not want the material returned and that she would leave it up to the FBI as to whether or not it represented any kind of threat.

Although each recipient received a separate set of material, Ms. [redacted] forwarded only one copy for review.

It is noted that the return address on the material included no name, only "P. O. Box 821, Glendale, CA 91209."

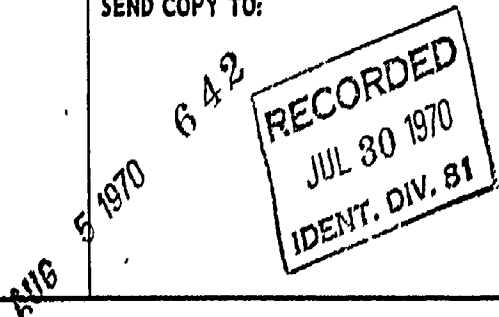
